
1 Introduction

1.1.1 This Technical Appendix shows the predicted turbine noise levels associated with the operation of the Proposed Development, the cumulative sites considered: Dunmaglass, Farr, Aberarder, and Glen Kyllachy wind farms, and the combined total at three neighbouring properties: H8 - Dalmigavie House, H15 - Glen Kyllachy Lodge, and H21 - Easter Strathnoon, with the smallest margins to the noise limits, taking into account wind direction effects and over a range of standardised 10 m height wind speeds, as described within **Chapter 11** of the EIAR.


